## **INKJET ONLY PRODUCT**



Gloss Clear Polyester with permanent adhesive "GCP"

A Glossy Clear polyester for photo quality Ink Jet printing where a clear face material is also required. Suitable for virtually all models of Ink Jet printer. (Always try before you buy).

Face material properties: Grammage 110 gsm + or - 5%, Caliper (thickness) 80 microns + or - 7%, Opacity Clear

Adhesive

A permanent, acrylic based adhesive with good tack & adhesion on a wide range of surfaces. Whilst maintaining good stability during laser printing.

Suitable for use on Dry, Non-Fatty food stuff according to ISEGA food stuffs certification.

Minimum application temp. +5°C, Storage range once applied -20°C to +80°C

Backing

A bleached kraft paper with good lay-flatness & stability

Thickness 85 microns + or - 4%

Grammage 85 gsm + or - 5%

Environmental & Handling.

Paper components are either ECF or TCF grade manufactured using pulp from sustainable, managed resources. All dimensions are nominal target specifications but may vary. All products within our range are manufactured to ISO 9001:2015 and BRC standards, the factory is also PEFC and FSC certified. The raw material laminates are also made to the same ISO standards as above and to ISO 14001. The product packaging is designed to maintain original ideal RH levels and will survive being stored in a wide range of temperatures; however, it is essential that the material is allowed to recover to normal print room temperatures for a min of 48 hours before use. Best print room conditions are 20 deg C and 50% RH.

Markets and Uses

This material gives a Gloss finish so ideal for use on glossy marketing brochures or packaging but only using Inkjet printers (not suitable for laser printing). Material is commonly used to give a No Label Look for postal items or for printed boxes or envelopes where a colour needs to be matched – the clear label can be put over the print on the box, etc. to give the impression of a colour matched label. This is a strong material that is hard to tear so is very durable. Also used on products that last a long time, so label and instructions stay intact – i.e. paints, varnishes, chemicals.
